In the library, there are books with wonderful pictures here, there, and everywhere!



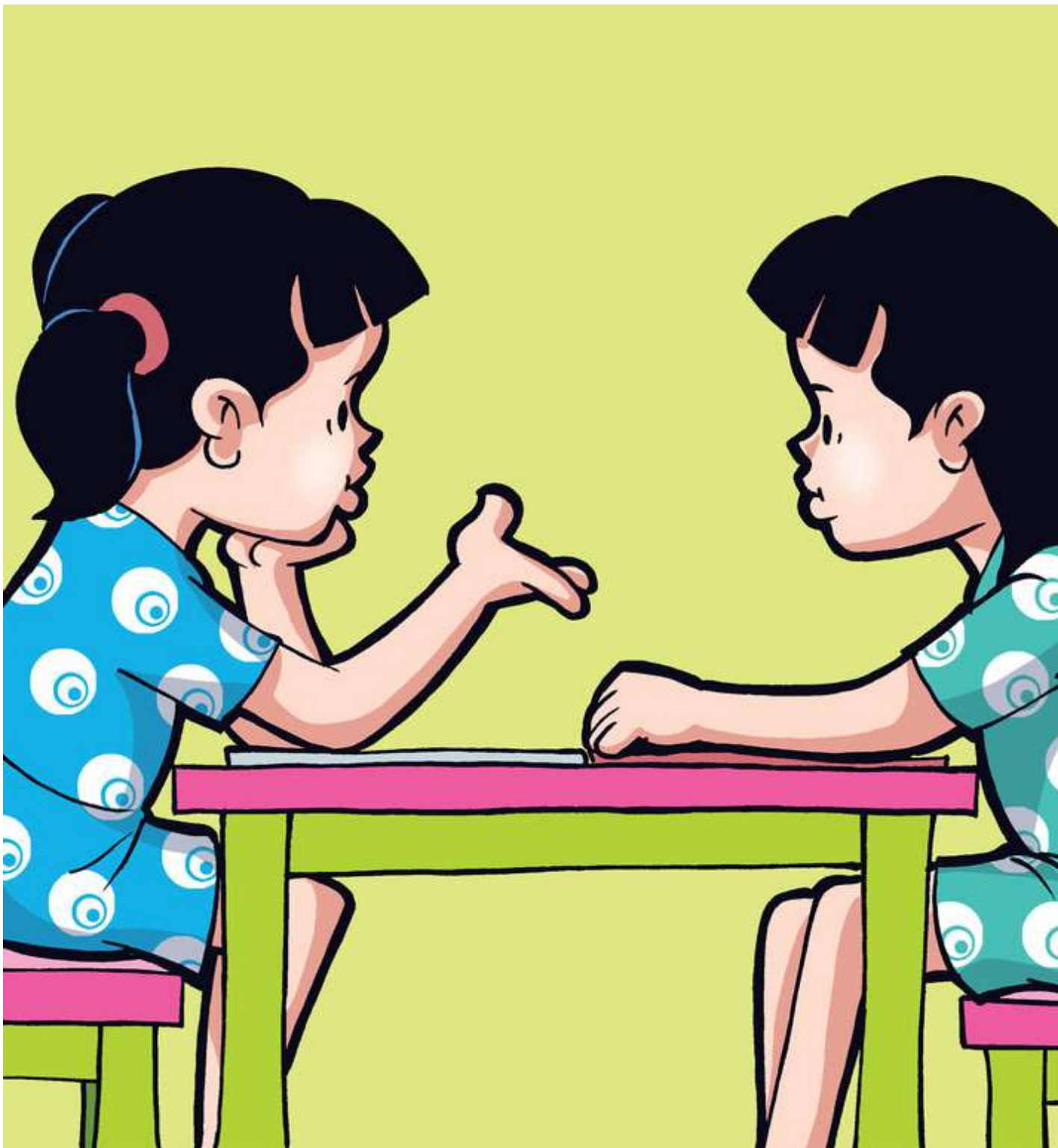


"Chunu, read this. It is a book filled with songs."
